Autumn 1 - **Who am I?** - The children will be settling in Nursery and begin to learn about themselves.

Important information for Nursery

Your child's details

You need make sure you have filled in all forms. Ensure you tell us about any allergies and medical conditions. Please tell us if you change phone numbers or address.

Punctuality

Morning Nursery starts between 8.45 and 9.15; at 9.15 we lock the gate. Afternoon Nursery starts between 12:15 and 12:45; at 12:45 we lock the gate. You will NOT be allowed into Nursery after this time and you will have to take your child home. If you know you are going to be late the next day because of an appointment, please let us know in advance and only then we will let your child in after 9.15 or 12:45.

Bringing and collecting your child

Please let us know who will be collecting your child from Nursery every day. If a different person will be collecting, tell us before. If we don't know a different person is collecting your child, we will not let your child go and will telephone you.

Clothing/Uniform

Curwen primary has a uniform but your child does NOT need to wear it for Nursery. Your child may get messy because we have paints, sand, water and a digging area, so do not dress them in fancy clothes. We play outside a lot so make sure they have warm clothes in winter and ensure sensible shoes. Inside the child's book bag please include some spare clothes in case we need to change them.

Water bottle and snack

Please bring a water bottle every day for your child and put their name on it. Your child will have a piece of fruit or vegetable every day, and the choice of milk. Do NOT bring any other food in their book bags.

Homework We will begin to give your child homework once a week after half term, please talk to them about what they are learning and what they enjoy at Nursery.

Library books We will begin to visit the library every Tuesday after half term. Your child can take a library book home. They will need a suitable book bag with their name on; we encourage you to read with your child at home every day. This develops their communication and language skills.

P.E Nursery children will take part in P.E every Friday. Please ensure they wear suitable footwear such as trainers to take part.

Other Useful Information:

Please ensure all items of clothing, school bags are clearly labelled with your child's name (please note that names can fade after washes so please check regularly). If you wish to speak to any of the Nursery team please make an appointment either by speaking to us after school or by ringing the school office. We look forward to welcoming your child to Nursery and that your child has a great term.
