

- Signalong is a communication system based on British Sign Language (BSL). Signalong uses speech, gestures, body language and facial expression to communicate with those who find it difficult to use and understand spoken language.
- Signalong uses about 8,000 signs / gestures!

Not every school uses Signalong to help children communicate. British Sign Language or Makaton can also be used.
