- French is a Romance language **spoken by 354 million people**. It descended from the Vulgar Latin of the Roman Empire, as did all Romance languages.
- It is **the third most spoken language in Europe**, after German and English, and is also **spoken in parts of Africa, North America, South America, Asia and Oceania**.

French is an official language in Belgium, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Canada, Central African Republic, Chad, Comoros, Côte d'Ivoire, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, France, Gabon, Guinea, Haiti, Luxembourg, Madagascar, Mali, Monaco, Niger, Republic of the Congo, Rwanda, Senegal, Seychelles, Switzerland, Togo, and Vanuatu.

Good afternoon	<u>今日は</u> (konnichiwa)
Welcome	<u>ようこそ</u> (yōkoso)
Thank you	<u>ありがとうございます</u> (arigatō)
Yes	<u>はい</u> (hai)
No	<u>いや</u> (iya)
Goodbye	<u>さようなら</u> (sayōnara)
What is your name?	<u>お名前はなんですか？</u> (o-namae wa nan desu ka)
My name is...	<u>...だ</u> (... da)
How are you?	<u>お元気ですか？</u> (o genki desu ka)
I'm fine, thanks. And you?	<u>はい、元気です。あなたは？</u> (hai, genki desu. Anata wa?)
