Where it is spoken

Bengali is the national and official language of **Bangladesh**, and one of the 23 official languages recognised by the **Republic of India**. It is written using the Bengali alphabet.

Bengali is the second most spoken language in India.

With about 250 million native and about 300 million total speakers worldwide, it is the 7th most spoken language in the world by total number of native speakers.
