Equipment List

Your child **WILL** need:

- 1x cabin bag weighing up to 10 kg with maximum dimensions of 55cm x 40cm x 20cm
- 4-5x pairs of underwear LABELLED
- 4-5x pairs of socks LABELLED
- 5x T-shirts LABELLED + 1 school P.E. t-shirt LABELLED
- 1x light rain coat /jacket LABELLED
- 2x Thin sweatshirts LABELLED
- 3x light wear trousers/ shorts
- 1 pair of pyjamas LABELLED
- 1 Towel (the children will have a shower each evening) LABELLED
- 1X Flip-flops or water proof slipper LABELLED
- 100ml or Less travel size bottles of shampoo (if needed) /body wash
- Tooth paste 100ml or less
- Toothbrush
- Flannel
- 100ml or less travel size sun cream
- Roll on deodorant
- Sanitary protection (girls only)
- If you have asthma you **MUST** bring 2 pumps LABELLED
- 2 pairs of comfortable footwear LABELLED (no open toed footwear)
- Any medication needed in a **CLEARLY** labelled bag with your child's name, it should be listed when it should be taken (this will be handed to the main office Monday 6th June – To Miss Tisser)

Your child **CAN** bring:

- A book to read in the evening
- Up to £20 spending money for the educational visit (We will not be going to the airport shop).
- Your child will need £10 extra to buy breakfast at Stansted and lunch at Madrid airport
- A camera (one they don't mind losing/dropping or breaking!)
- A sandwich, crisps, light snacks and a fruit for flight (must fit in draw string bag)

You must **collect**:

- A note book and pencil
- A group draw string bag, cap, jumper and t-shirt (£10 per child)

Your child must **NOT** bring:

- Any electrical equipment i.e. PSP's, game boys, Ipads, MP3 Players, Ipods etc.
- Mobile phones
