I know that this week many of you will be doing more after the slight relaxation of the lockdown rules. However, many of the restrictions are still in place and we will be continuing to following these with our current offer, until we inform you otherwise. During this time I would like to encourage you to work with your children and to talk to them about their personal space and also hygiene procedures, including washing hands regularly and using a tissue and placing this in a bin.
