Home Learning and Remote Education

In the current times, we realise that there may be times when children are well but unable to attend school. This may be because: someone in their household has symptoms or has tested positive for covid-19; someone in their household is waiting for test results; their class 'bubble' has been asked to self-isolate at home due to a positive case.

We realise that nothing can replace learning in person for children, however to ensure children miss out as little as possible we have developed procedures for home learning and remote education. In order for children to get the most out of home learning, then we need parents and carers to encourage and support them with accessing their lessons and completing work set.

Children are expected to participate fully in home learning whilst not at school unless you report their absence through Studybugs.

If your child's bubble is isolating and you do not attend Zoom lessons then someone from school will phone you each week to check on your child's learning and offer support if needed.

Home learning pack.

A home learning pack will be provided for all children with work to cover their isolation period. We will let you know how you can collect them from school. Your child must return this to school once they are back, and will be given the chance to discuss their learning with a member of staff.

CGP textbooks.

All children were sent with CGP text books in October. They may be directed to complete home learning activities using these to help.

Zoom lessons.

If your child's whole class is isolating, daily Zoom learning with their class teacher will be arranged. This information will be sent to you via **Studybugs**.

If your child is isolating, but the rest of the class is in school then we will send you details to allow them to Zoom into their class' lessons. This information will be sent to you via **Studybugs**.

What else can your child do at home?

Reading is so important, so please read with your child every day. They can use their library book, school library book, read magazines or books at home – whatever they find interesting!

We have received a limited number chromebooks from the DfE which are able to be lent to parents. We have to prioritise children entitled to Free School Meals for this, however if you would like to

borrow a laptop for your child to use then please contact school. You will need to complete our **loan agreement** and ensure this is returned to school when your child returns.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, we will also contact you about a weekly food parcel which you can collect from school.
