Use time conjunctions (before, next and after) to show when things happen	Adverbs including fronted adverbial adverbs of manner, adverbs of degree, place and time
Semicolon to separate two independent clauses	Commas for list
Use of modal verbs: can/could, may/might, will/would, shall/should and must	Colons for list and provide information to a given clause

Features of a Biography

- Opening sentence hooks the reader
- Use of rhetorical questions
- Opening paragraph sums up the person's life
- Written in the 3rd person
- Use of past tense verbs
- Key incidents in subject's life
- Chronological order and connectives
- Dates, names and places for factual description
- Anecdotal style to make it interesting for the reader
- Concluding paragraph:
- Sum up the person's character
- State their importance in their field
- State how they'll be remembered
- Include opinion
- Relate the subject to the reader by ending with a question that links to the ones in the opening paragraph

$$3^3 = 27$$

$$4^3 = 64$$

$$5^3 = 125$$

$$6^3 = 216$$

$$7^3 = 343$$

$$8^3 = 512$$

$$9^3 = 729$$

$$10^3 = 1000$$
