

Dear Parents and Carers

Congratulations to you all! Together we have got through 8 weeks of a totally different and new way of working and learning. We have been AMAZED by the fantastic efforts of our children working at home and in school, and so proud by how everyone has supported each other. Thank you!

As you are aware, we are currently still under national lockdown restrictions. As we are sure you understand, we want to keep everyone as safe as possible so ask everyone to work together to follow the restrictions. If you are unsure, then please contact school and we will be happy to help you with advice and pointing you in the direction of local testing centres. Lots of our staff and families have vulnerable people at home, and if we all follow this advice this can help to safeguard us all and mean we don't have to send bubbles home.

Our start and end times will still be the same from Monday, and breakfast and 6 o'clock club will be running. Please remember that we have 20 minute windows to spread everyone out, so please do not arrive early which results in queuing. All parents/carers will be requested to wear a face covering unless exempt. Please do not be offended if staff ask you to wear a face covering, or display a lanyard to avoid this if you are exempt. We have lots of staff in the playground, so you are welcome to drop your child/ren at the gates and not enter the playground if you prefer not to put on a face covering.

We will continue to send out information via Studybugs, so please continue to check this regularly. There will be letters coming home about parents' evening next week, so please look out for this too.

Within this newsletter, we are including information about the census coming up this month. Please complete this, or come into school and we will be happy to help you. Newham receives money based on census, so if all our families fill it in we might all get a bit more in these difficult times.
