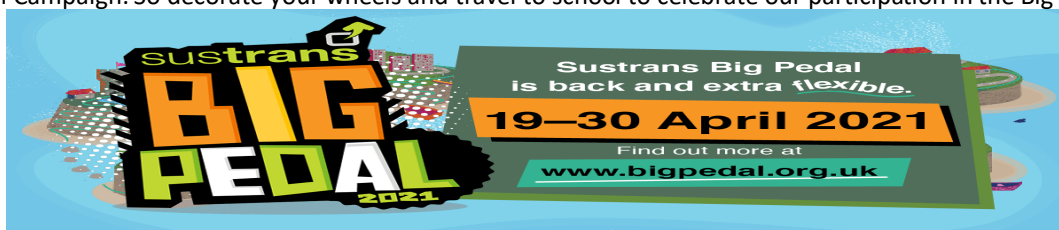

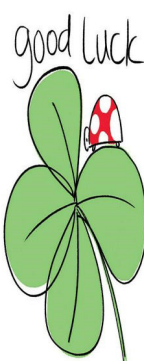
Newham will be digitally hosting a DLA form filling support sessions for parents and carers of special needs children 0-7 years in Newham (28th April – 19th May 2021).
