Newham have asked us to remind everyone about the need to apply for the EUSS the deadline is 30th June 2021. EU citizens and family members **must** apply to the EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS) by 30th June 2021 to secure their right to continue living and working in the UK. You **must also apply to the scheme for your child/ren** if they were born in the UK but do not have British citizenship. Many EU citizen parents have not yet applied on behalf of their children, and it is vital to secure your child's immigration status.
