We realised that with all our Zoom sessions children are using screens more than many of you would rather. We have had several concerns raised with us relating to online safety, and we would like to reiterate the importance of all parents monitoring and discussing online safety with your children whilst they are at home.

These following simple rules might be helpful for your child to follow:

-Only being allowed to use a device (including a mobile phone) in shared rooms within your home (e.g. kitchen, lounge) with the doors open

-Not taking their phone / device to bed with them, but leaving them in a shared area until morning

-Identifying a person at home who they can talk to if they receive or see something upsetting when using their devices

-Showing an adult any videos they would like to upload to social media accounts before they upload them

-Reminding children that online behaviour must be as 'real life' behaviour. This means that if they would not ordinarily say, share or show something to someone in 'real life' that they probably shouldn't be doing so online either

-Ensuring children have privacy settings on their accounts so that only their friends can access them








# **Nursery Spaces Available**

### **Education Psychologist Sessions**

Parent advice sessions are offered to any parent or carer who would like to discuss concerns about their child with an educational psychologist (examples may include: your child's emotional well-being, challenging behaviours, learning progress, your relationship with your child or some of your own worries). These sessions aim to be supportive and informal. The nature of the concerns will be recorded to assist the school in planning future parent support. The Parent advice sessions are one-off telephone sessions that do not necessarily result in follow-up work. If it is felt that follow-up work may be beneficial, the educational psychologist will discuss with the parents before sharing the information with school. Each session is up to 1 hour.
