

If positive, email info@curwen.ttl.academy

Put the subject of the email: **POSITIVE TEST RESULT**

Make sure you include:

1. Your child's name
2. Your child's class



3. The date they were last in school

A copy of the positive test result (as an attachment or copied and pasted)

Scenario B:

Your child develops **symptoms** on **Monday 5th April 2021** or ANY days after.

Book a test **as soon as possible**.

You **do not** need to inform us unless your child's isolation dates mean they cannot return on Tuesday 20th April 2021.

Big Pedal Challenge

We are taking part in the Sustrans Big Pedal Campaign from Monday 19th April to 30th April over 10 days. It is the UK's largest inter-school cycling, walking and scooting challenge inspiring pupils, staff and parents to choose human power for their journey to school.
