Dear Parents and Carers

As we said in a message earlier this week, thank you to all of our parents who have been following all of our requests with regards to face coverings, staggering drop off and pick ups and with your understanding of the restrictions we currently have in place. This includes requesting that children are on time for school, which avoids them having to walk through bubbles of other children within school. In addition if appointments cannot be made outside of the school day, children must only be collected or dropped to school at 12:00 or 1:00 by prior arrangement. We do realise that these can cause inconvenience, however due to the pandemic we feel these measures are needed to reduce levels of transmission. We would ask that even if frustrated by this that you do not take this out on school staff, or other parents and carers in and around school. We teach the children in school about kindness and respect, and expect this to be shown by adults as well.

This week we received some fantastic news that the school has been awarded Certified School status by National Online Safety. This is a fantastic achievement that we are very proud of. Parents and carers can access online resources from National Online Safety, so do download their app.

This week at school we have been marking 'Dying Matters' at school. As a school we have been getting involved by having discussions and reflection time and designing candles. This is a very sensitive subject so we would like you to be aware this has taken place. In addition, Newham is putting on a number of events for residents to get involve with and offering support for different things. Newham are inviting residents to light a candle **on Friday 14th May**. Residents can put a candle in their window to remember residents who have died during the pandemic.
