Speech and Language—Extra Support



This year, our school is buying in extra speech and language therapy from East London NHS Foundation Trust. The speech and language therapist will be in one day a week working in classrooms and with teachers and teaching assistants.

All children may work with her at times. School may ask her to observe your child so that she can provide school-based recommendations. If you would not like for this to happen, please let the school staff know.

If you have concerns about your child's speech, language or communication, please speak with school staff in the first instance. If there is a need to work one-to-one with your child or to carry out further assessment, you will receive a letter to request your permission.

The therapist would then make contact with you either before or after assessment.

Childcare Services— Breakfast Club and 6 O'clock Club

We know how hard every parent works and understand that sometimes it may be complicated to drop off and pick up the children considering your working schedule. We are here to support you and would like to remind you all of the childcare services that we provide.

Breakfast Club runs between 7:45AM—8:30AM Monday to Friday at a charge of £0.80 per session. The children are provided with breakfast and various activities for a great start to the day. Please note that you can drop your child off without pre-booking or paying on the day; the bill is automatically sent at the end of the week via SchoolMoney.

6 O'clock Club runs between 3:30PM—6:00PM Monday to Friday at a charge of £10 per session. The children are provided with a snack and various fun activities as well as help with their homework. Please note this is an invite only club therefore, before attending, a contract needs to be collected and signed from the main office. Bookings need to be made the Friday prior to the week you wish your child to attend, via SchoolMoney.
