On the 5th May, the school is likely to be closed for polling day. If this is the case, children will be having online lessons. More details to follow.

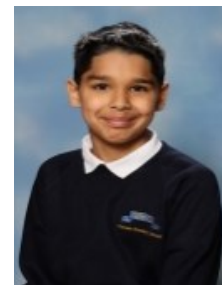
