Collection is **3:15pm**. We already have educational visits underway, and would like to remind you that **school will provide a packed lunch to all children**. Please do take up this offer (a choice of tuna, cheese or chicken), but do feel free to send them with some extra snacks if you would like.

Childcare Services - Breakfast Club and 6 O'clock Club

We know how hard every parent works and understand that sometimes it may be complicated to drop off and pick up the children considering your working schedule. We are here to support you and would like to remind you all of the childcare services that we provide.

Breakfast Club runs between 7:45AM—8:30AM Monday to Friday at a charge of £0.80 per session. The children are provided with breakfast and various activities for a great start to the day. Please note that you can drop your child off without pre-booking or paying on the day; the bill is automatically sent at the end of the week via SchoolMoney.

6 O'clock Club runs between 3:30PM—6:00PM Monday to Friday at a charge of £10 per session. The children are provided with a snack and various fun activities, as well as help with their homework. Please note, this is an invite only club, therefore, before attending, a contract needs to be collected and signed from the main office. Bookings need to be made the Friday prior to the week you wish your child to attend, via SchoolMoney.
