We all understand how difficult it can be to keep up with all of the apps, games and websites that children like to access. However, we need parents to ensure they are talking to their child/ren about what they are watching and checking that it is suitable and safe. Unfortunately, it is all too easy for children to accidentally access very unsuitable materials, and there are some very unpleasant people out there who may try to contact children through games and apps. We strongly recommend that children do not have mobile phones, tablets or devices in their bedrooms, and that when they are accessing these they do so with an adult in the room to monitor what is being accessed. We will always act on any concerns raised within school, but preventing children accessing inappropriate materials is far better.

This week has seen our year 4 children spend a day at Stubbers taking part in adventurous activities. We hope they had a wonderful day, and a big thank you goes to all of the staff that volunteered to take them.
