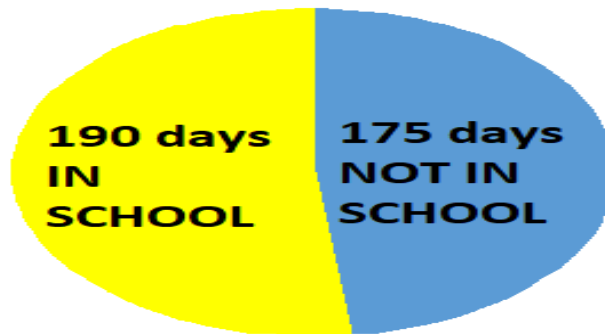

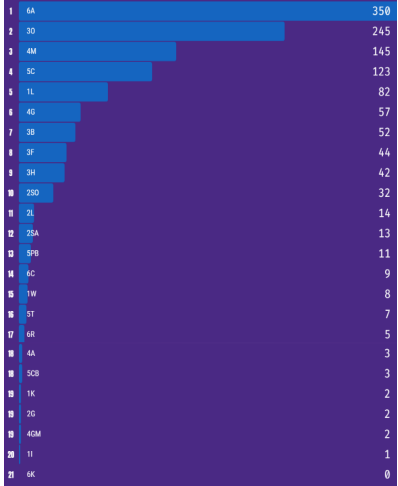




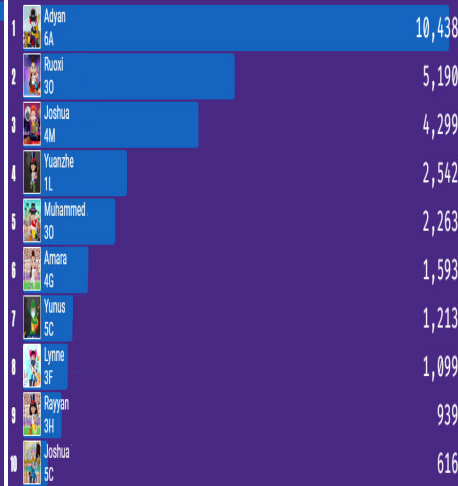

The first race was the Boys 25m final where Curwen narrowly finished second in the heat to secure a silver medal. This success was followed up by another silver medal in the Boys 4 x 25m relay.
