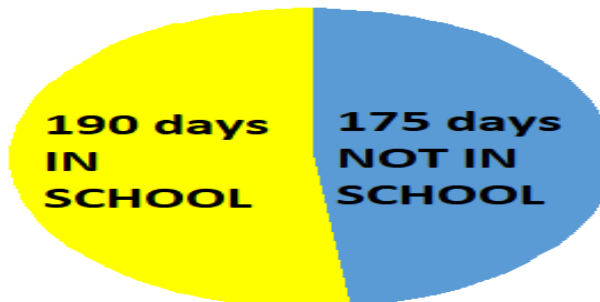
Our first charity event of the year is next Friday 20th September where children are invited to wear jeans and donate 50p for Jeans for Genes. We hope you have a lovely weekend!
