5CB took part in Junior Roadwatch on Tuesday, 3rd June. We were located at Upper Road at the junction with Chesterton Road.

Junior Roadwatch gives primary school children the opportunity to take part in speed awareness engagement in their local community near their school. Children work with Police Officers to educate speeding motorists on the importance of road danger reduction.

Our pupils had an opportunity to use a speed gun with the Police Officer to identify motorists travelling over national police guidelines. The speeders were stopped by the officer, who carried out a Police National Computer check on the driver. If they were deemed to be suitable, they were given a choice of receiving an enforcement or receiving an educational road safety message from the children.

We talked to several speed perpetrators who definitely were feeling embarrassed and understood that they should not speed.
