We have been so impressed this week with the amount of Student Leader application forms we have received! We are very excited to develop more leadership skills with this year's cohort.

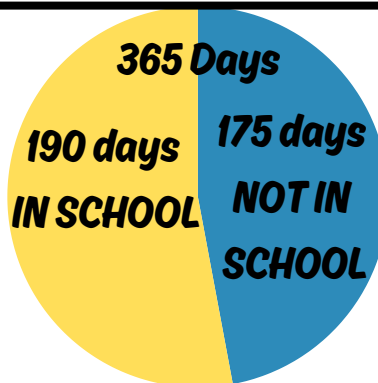
