A very Happy Diwali to all our families celebrating. We hope you have a lovely time.

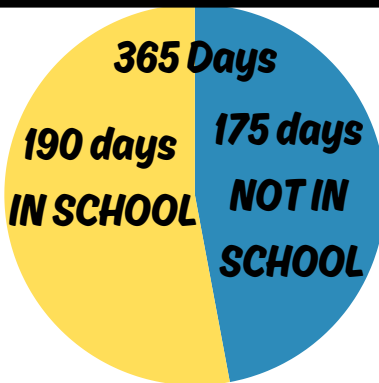
