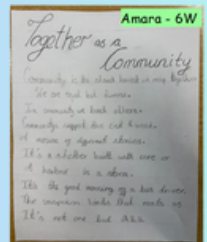
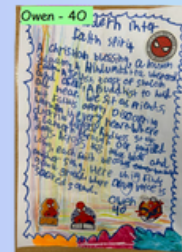
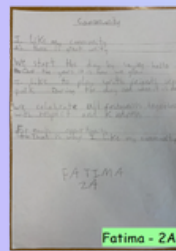
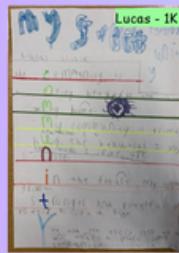
## Inter Faith Week
