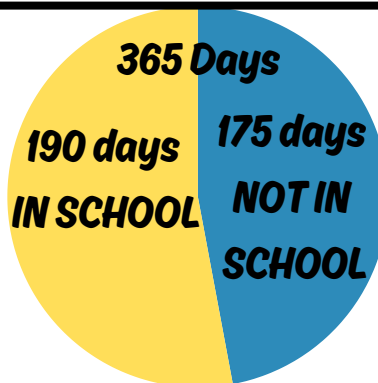

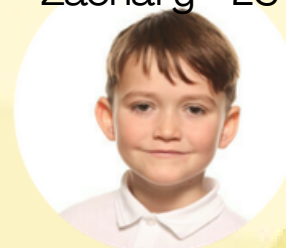
International Week reflects the rich cultural diversity presented in Newham and the wider London community.
