We are also marking St George's Day next week. We invite children to wear something red and white to school, and will have a special lunch in school. Children will be talking about St George's day in their class assemblies next week.

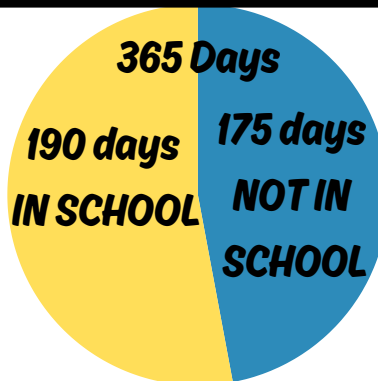

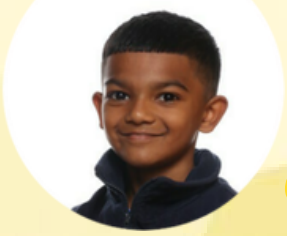
