Over the coming weeks, we have lots of events happening. Please do keep checking Studybugs and our 'Diary Dates' on the school website.

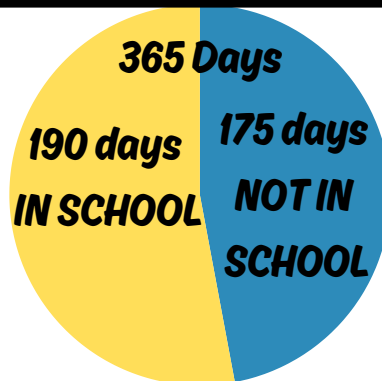
