As temperatures are due to rise next week, please remember to apply sunscreen before school and provide a hat and a water bottle.

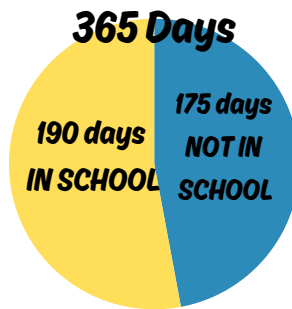
