This summer, children, young people and families across Newham can take part in a wide range of activities, clubs, events and support offers taking place across the borough. This brochure brings together information about the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme, alongside other free and low-cost opportunities available during the school holidays.

The HAF programme provides free holiday activities and food for eligible children and young people, including those who receive income-related Free School Meals. Alongside HAF, there are also other activities and local offers that families may wish to explore, including community events, library activities, youth provision, family support and other summer opportunities.

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Free Holiday Activities for Children and Young People

The Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme provides free holiday activities and healthy meals for children and young people aged 4–16 (Reception to Year 11) who are eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals.

This summer, children and young people can enjoy a wide range of fun, engaging and enriching activities delivered by trusted local organisations across Newham. This Summer, there are over **60 different programmes running!**

What's on Offer?

There is something for everyone, including:

- Multi-sports and physical activities
- Dance and performing arts
- Music and creative workshops
- Arts and crafts
- Drama and theatre activities
- Cooking and healthy eating sessions
- Outdoor adventures and enrichment activities
- Specialist SEND provision

Every session includes a free healthy meal, giving children the opportunity to stay active, learn new skills, make friends and have fun throughout the school holidays.

The programme is open to children and young people who:

- Are aged 4–16 (Reception to Year 11)
- Live in or attend school in Newham
- Are eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals

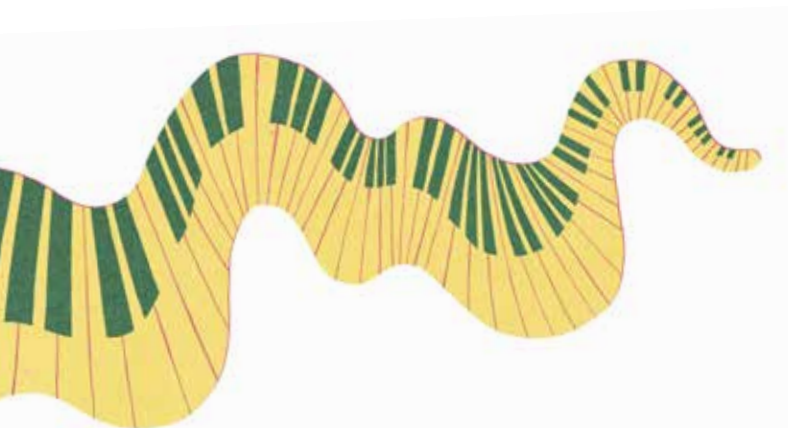
