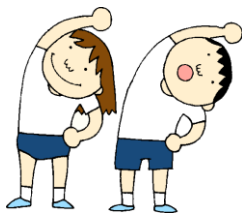
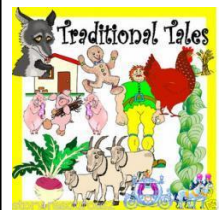
WHAT ARE WE LEARNING?

Reception - Spring Term 2020

Our Topic is:

Spring 1 - '**My stories**'. We will be reading, sharing and acting out a variety of traditional stories. We will focus on the characters in the stories, where the stories take place and the sequence of events that occur in each story.

Spring 2- '**People in our Community**'. We will be talking and learning about different people who work at school and the jobs they do. We will also be visiting West Ham Park and having some people come in to talk about their jobs.

Your child will need a **blue Curwen P.E t-shirt** and shorts or tracksuit bottoms with suitable trainers. Please bring you child's P.E kit at the beginning of the week so it remains in school. It will be sent home on Friday.

Parent's Morning every Monday

Every Monday morning you are invited into your child's classroom where you can spend some time engaging in the activities available. We also welcome and invite you to in class contributing to your child's Special book.



Homework and Reading Time:

Homework will be handed out every Friday and needs to be handed back into class by Wednesday of the following week. Please support us by ensuring your child completes the homework by themselves.

Children are given a Reading Time book, and a yellow Reading Record book. The Reading Time book will be read in class with your child's class teacher and also needs to be read at home with you. We welcome written comments in their yellow Reading Record book which will contribute to your child being entered into the weekly Reading Raffle.

Each class will visit the school library where your child can select a book. It can be changed the following week on the same day. Sometimes the days may vary so please ensure your child keeps their Reading Time **and** library books in their school bag, after it is read at home. We strongly recommend that you read with your child every day to promote communication and language development.
